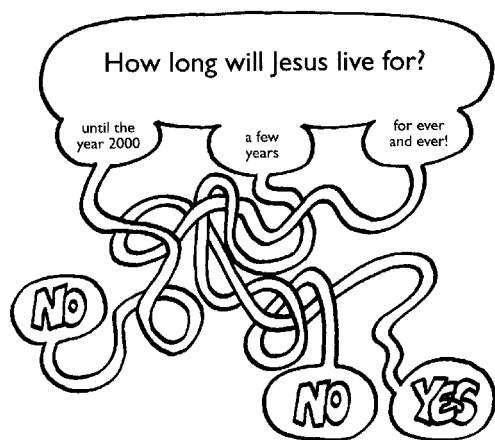


# Future Events
